# LEADERS WITHOUT THE FIRE

In every generation, God raises leaders to shepherd His people, carry His presence, and advance His Kingdom. However, one of the greatest dangers in ministry is not opposition, persecution, or lack of resources—it is the absence of spiritual fire.

A leader may have position, influence, and structure, yet lack the one thing that gives life to ministry: the fire of God. When the fire is missing, leadership becomes mechanical, ministry becomes routine, and the church becomes spiritually dry.

This teaching addresses the critical need for leaders to not only lead—but to lead with fire.

### **Understanding the Fire of God**

The fire of God represents His presence, power, purity, and passion working in and through a leader.

### **Biblical Foundation:**

- *"Our God is a consuming fire."* (**Hebrews 12:29**)
- *"Did not our hearts burn within us...?"* (**Luke 24:32**)

The fire is:

- The evidence of intimacy with God
- The source of spiritual authority

- The power behind effective ministry

Without this fire, leadership becomes human effort rather than divine assignment.

### **The Danger of Leading Without the Fire**

A leader without fire may still function—but cannot transform lives.

### **Key Signs of Fireless Leadership:**

#### **a. Dependence on Structure Over Spirit**

Programs replace prayer. Strategy replaces surrender. The church runs, but God is not moving.

#### **b. Loss of Spiritual Sensitivity**

Leaders no longer discern the voice of God. Decisions are made by logic alone, not revelation.

#### **c. Absence of Conviction and Power**

Messages become informational rather than transformational. There is no anointing to break yokes.

#### **d. Burnout and Emptiness**

When the fire of God is absent, leaders rely on their own strength—leading to exhaustion and discouragement.

**e. Reproduction of Spiritual Dryness**

A fireless leader produces a fireless church. What is not burning in the leader cannot burn in the people.

**Biblical Examples of Fireless Leadership**

**a. The Sons of Aaron (Leviticus 10:1-2)**

They offered “strange fire” before the Lord—ministry not initiated by God. The result was judgment.

**Lesson:** God does not accept substituted fire. Authentic ministry must be birthed from His presence.

**b. Samson (Judges 16:20)**

*“He did not know that the Lord had departed from him.”*

Samson maintained the appearance of strength, but the presence of God had left him.

**Lesson:** It is possible to continue functioning while spiritually empty.

**Characteristics of Leaders With the Fire**

**a. Deep Intimacy With God**

They prioritize prayer, worship, and the Word above all else.

**b. Sensitivity to the Holy Spirit**

They are led, directed, and corrected by God continually.

**c. Boldness and Authority**

They speak with conviction, not uncertainty. Their words carry weight.

**d. Passion for Souls and Revival**

Their hearts burn for the lost and for the awakening of the church.

**e. Consistent Spiritual Renewal**

They guard their spiritual lives intentionally and daily.

**How Leaders Lose the Fire**

**a. Neglect of Personal Devotion**

Ministry replaces relationship with God.

**b. Sin and Compromise**

Small compromises gradually extinguish spiritual passion.

**c. Familiarity With Holy Things**

Sacred responsibilities become routine and lose their reverence.

**d. Overwork Without Renewal**

Constant output without spiritual input leads to depletion.



**Biblical Charge:**

- *“Fan into flame the gift of God...” (2 Timothy 1:6)*

**Steps to Restoration:**

**a. Return to the Secret Place**

Prioritize time alone with God—beyond sermon preparation.

**b. Repent and Realign**

Address anything that has quenched the Spirit.

**c. Reignite Passion Through the Word**

Engage Scripture not just for teaching, but for transformation.

**d. Restore Dependence on the Holy Spirit**

Invite Him back into every aspect of leadership and ministry.

**e. Surround Yourself With Fire-Carriers**

Stay connected to leaders and environments that cultivate spiritual passion.

**The Responsibility of Fire-Carrying Leaders**

Leaders are not only called to carry fire—they are called to release it.

**Your Role Is To:**

- Ignite hunger in the congregation
- Model a life of spiritual intensity
- Create an atmosphere where God's presence is welcomed
- Raise other leaders who carry the same fire

A church will rarely rise above the spiritual temperature of its leadership.

Leadership without the fire of God is incomplete and ineffective. The call of God upon pastors and church leaders is not merely to manage people—but to steward His presence.

The world does not need more organized churches—it needs burning leaders. Leaders whose hearts are set ablaze with the presence of God. Leaders who speak with authority, live with purity, and lead with power.

**Final Charge:**

Guard the fire.

Pursue the fire.


Lead with the fire.
